## 3 General market development

There was little sign of the New Year's mood on the stock markets. The German stock exchanges said goodbye to a weak trading year 2022, mostly with losses.

The DAX fell by more than 1 percent to 13,924 points. Over the year as a whole, the German stock exchange barometer fell by around 12 percent.

The Russian war of aggression in Ukraine, high inflation and significant interest rate hikes put pressure on the market over the course of the year.

The biggest losers in the DAX were Vonovia and Zalando, whose prices fell by well over 50 percent.

2022 is coming to an end and some investors are going bargain hunting again. Concerns about the massive increase in the number of infections in China after the government in Beijing recently relaxed the corona virus had recently put pressure on prices. That was used on Wall Street. The bargain hunters grabbed it. The battered technology stocks in particular went up.

In Asia, investors follow the good US guidelines. The Nikkei Index in Tokyo rose 0.3 percent, the Shanghai Composite rose 0.6 percent.
